Purpose

This policy sets our approach to the recognition of prior learning and achievement for the purpose of achieving an end-point assessment qualification.

Scope

The scope of this policy is for all end-point assessments delivered by EUIAS. This policy has been designed to meet the requirements of Ofqual General Conditions of Recognition (Condition E10).

Policy Statement

EUIAS does not recognise any apprentice prior learning or prior achievement for the purpose of achieving the requirements of any end-point assessments.

This policy does not affect the Gateway requirements which must be met in order for an apprentice to be eligible for end-point assessment.

This policy does not affect any reasonable adjustments that may be granted.

In order for EUIAS to award an end-point assessment qualification, the apprentice must successfully complete all required assessment components with EUIAS.

Review

This policy will be reviewed annually.
