#### What are they?

We are approved to deliver Street Works Operative and Supervisor Certificates. Upon successful completion of the Street Works Certificate(s), learners will receive a qualification certificate from EUIAS. Individuals, their training provider or employer can then separately apply for a SWQR card.

Learners must complete the Key Certificates before progressing onto the additional Certificates, for both Operative and Supervisor.

#### Who are they aimed at?

The Certificates in Street Works for Operatives and Supervisors meet the requirement within The New Roads and Street Works Act 1991 (NRSWA) for a qualified Operative to be on site at all times when street works are in progress. The Act also requires that the site is supervised by a person who holds the relevant Supervisor Certificates.

Each Certificate provides learners with the underpinning knowledge, understanding and skills required for each activity performed by Operatives and Supervisors working in Street Works.

### When do they expire?

Street Works Certificates are valid for five years.

Learners can renew their Street Works Certificate within the five years' by completing the EUIAS Re-assessment of each Certificate. If a learner wishes to renew outside of the five years then a full Certificate must be completed.

#### How are the Certificates assessed?

EUIAS Street Works Certificates are assessed through both an online multiple choice test and a practical observation. Re-assessment Certificates are assessed through the online multiple choice test only.
