## Cable Jointers Attendant Qualification Launch Webinar

### **Questions and Answers**

#### Q. Are there additional costs if MCQ tests are failed? Is there a limit on the number of resits a candidate can take?

A. Resit fee for MCQ test is £10. Where a learner fails the MCQ test, they are entitled to one resit with EUIAS, at the discretion of the training provider.

#### Q. Will this qualification show on the EUSR Card /Website? If so how long will this be valid for?

A. There are no current plans to display the qualification on the EUSR Card. The qualification is valid for life and does not need to be re-sat. However, the Cable Jointer Attendant qualification might be determined as the appropriate qualification for the CSCS Skilled worker card for the role. This would be in addition to SHEA Power which would need to be achieved every three years.

# Q. Does the award cover self lay and distribution?

A. The award does not differentiate between either. It recognises the knowledge, understanding, and practical skills required to be effective in a range of contexts. If the role includes cable jointing, then this qualification will apply to those individuals.
